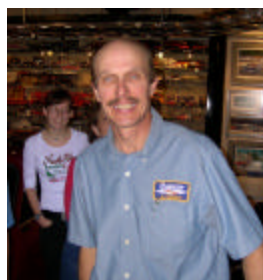

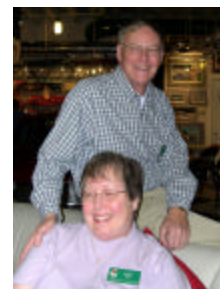

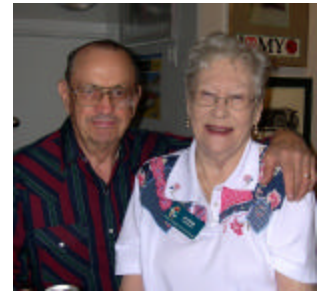

TECH TIPS: (reprinted from Queen City Corvair Club newsletter)

Tip Number One: Easy Oil Leak Fix. “An inexpensive way to stop some small oil leaks in your engine, specially in the fron and rear main seals, is to add one or two ounces of brake fluid. This will not reduce the lubricating qualities of your oil. there are additives designed to keep rubber parts soft and pliable. the front and rear main seals become hardened and take a set, allowing seepage of oil through the seal. If this has not progressed too far, the brake fluid will soften the seals and allow them to reseal. If the seals have already become crystallized or cracked, it won't help. But at the price of bake fluid it is work a try since the alternative is to replace the seals. This will also work on some power-glide transmissions.”

Tip Number Two: Milky Convertible Window: “Is the back window on your convertible becoming milky and cloudy? Use a foam type shaving cream on the plastic window to clear it. Put the foam on a damp sponge and the window well. This will clear the milky appearance.”
